AGENDA

On December 11, 2024 at 7:05pm, the regular meeting of the Board of the Bone Mesa Domestic Water District was held. This meeting was called to order at 12432 4050 Rd., Paonia, CO by Dan Buzzell Buzzell, President. Steve Smith, Vice President and Jacob Gray, Secretary/Treasurer were present, establishing a quorum. Kirk Morgan, Viva Kellogg, Emily Carroll and Jeremiah Garcia were also present.

Public Comments: None.

Jacob Gray made a motion to approve the November 20, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes.

Steve Smith seconded the motion, and all present were in favor.

Monthly Reports

Treasurer

Jacob reported: Bank account balances as of November 30, 2024 were: Checking: \$24,677.69, Emergency and Capital Improvements Reserve: \$115,445.55, Tap Installations Reserve: \$7,592.46 and UBB CD 11/28/23: \$104,270.64.

November income was \$10,039.68, plus \$425.35 interest income, expenses were \$18,613.82 and net loss was \$8,149.79.

The district's water rights are split amongst two other water rights holders, Jacob spoke with one of those water rights holders about installing a meter so they can measure their decree. Jacob informed that the other party that the project would need to happen soon for the District to be involved. The Town of Paonia Manager, Wynn, was unavailable for the month of December and Jacob will not be available until February to have a meeting with Town of Paonia. In January the District will discuss business to cover with Town of Paonia Administrator in February.

Jacob engaged Elevate about the line they recently installed immediately over the District's waterline. The two lines share a trench for about 1000'. This alignment can become problematic for the district, especially considering that the waterline has had 3 leaks in the last several months.

ORC

Kirk reported;

Line 1, on 3775 Rd, a new leak was found Nov 25th and repaired 12/10/24. The leak was non-emergency in nature. The pipeline runs approximately the length of 3775 rd.

Another leak found at 12509 Crawford rd. The bolts on a ³/₄" PRV broke on the Districts' Service line. Kendall construction made the repair. Afterwards, the connection to the customer's meter yoke had a leak on the customer's size. The plumbing on customer's plumbing was subpar in terms of construction material used, but asked the Board to consider billing forgiveness if the overages were excessive due to the leak occurring after contract's made their repair.

Collected Nitrates, VOC, SOC and Lead & Copper samples. Needs to retrieve 2019 Nitrate results from SGS labs.
